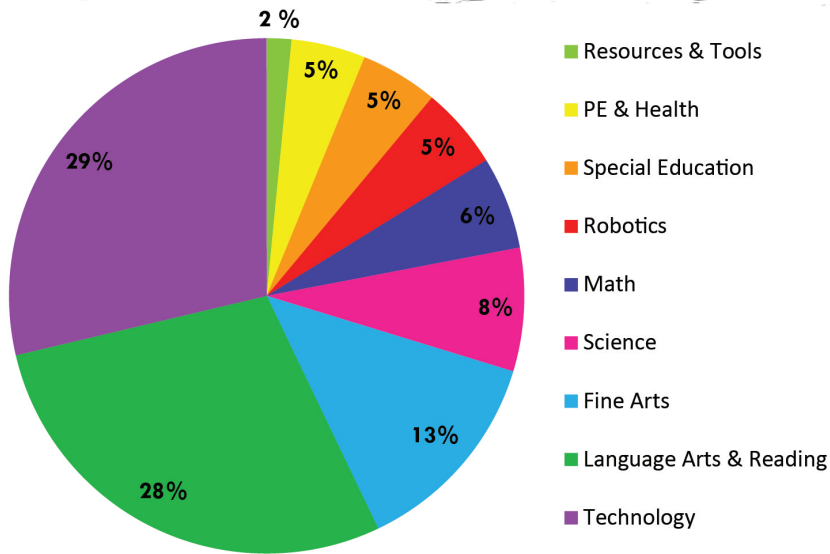

Elkhorn High School	<u>Newsela Pro</u>	Newsela partners with multiple daily news sources and nonfiction publishers to create readings for all content areas. The content surrounds everything from current events, famous speeches, primary sources and biographies. Newsela also allows teachers to assign the same content reading at multiple reading levels allowing teachers to scaffold and differentiate for the student's reading level. Newsela provides integrated activities such as annotations, standards aligned quizzes and writing prompts for every article at every single level to help teachers and administrators monitor student engagement in real time while also encouraging students to practice active reading strategies. All quizzes are aligned with ACT styled questions requiring students to actively participate in the reading process in order to succeed. Newsela PRO allows teachers to have a window into student reading in class in order to a holistic picture of each student. Teachers are able to assess student data and determine which areas of reading students excel in and which areas require additional support allowing teachers to make minute by minute decisions on not only content in the classroom but skill mastery. It allows teachers to provide direct interventions to struggling students in their specific area of difficulty.	Julia Wagener	9th & 10th	\$750.00
Elkhorn High School	<u>Robotics</u>	This grant would be used to purchase VEX replacement parts for the 3 EHS robotics teams. Robotics meets after school and is open to any student with interest in designing, building, programming and/or driving robots. Robotics is the ultimate PBL (problem based learning) experience - students learn through collaborative problem solving - developing critical and creative thinking skills. Students have opportunities to program, maintain an engineering journal, interview with judges, serve as co-captain, and collaborate with teams from other schools. Robotics is nearly year round with design work beginning during the summer, construction begins in August, and competitions run November through April. Probably the most important thing students develop is "learning agility" - knowing what to do when you don't know what to do - a critical life skill.	Kim Johnson	9th-12th	\$2,500.00
Elkhorn High School	<u>Document Camera for New English Teacher</u>	Each of the English teachers have a document camera that they use to model instruction and keep students active in daily lessons. It's a vital part to the classroom, and we are always so grateful for the foundation supporting on this each year.
