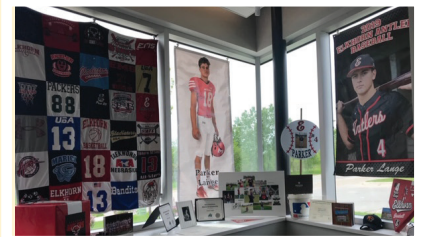

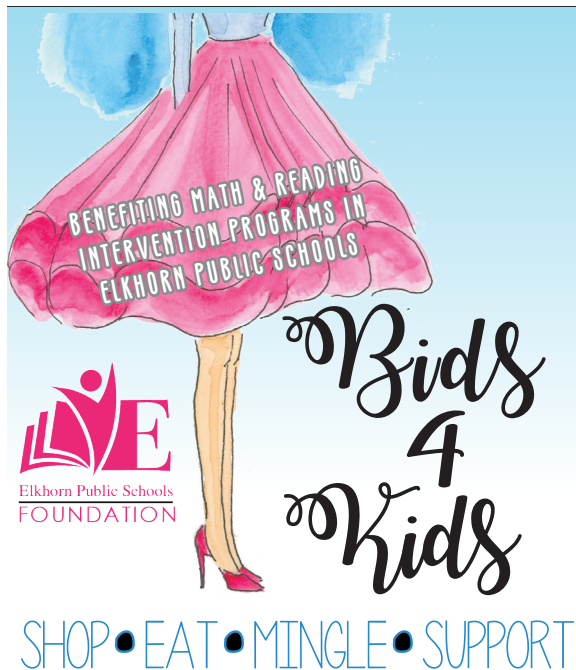

## The Elkhorn Public Schools Foundation hosted its 7th Annual Bids 4 Kids Ladies Night Out on April 4th at The Elkhorn Alumni Center.

With over 200 guests in attendance, the community event raised \$47,000 to help fund the Foundation's Math & Reading Intervention programs. This school year, over 500 students participated in the program, with teachers spending an additional 3,000 instructional hours outside of the normal school day to help increase students test scores, boost students confidence and improve overall reading and math comprehension. As the Elkhorn Public Schools District continues to grow, our Bids 4 Kids event will continue to be an important event to fund our intervention programs.

Over 200 local businesses and community partners donated auction items and raffle prizes for Bids 4 Kids! Almost all elementary and middle school PTOs donated a basket for the auction, and each school and coach in the district donated either school experiences or sports camps. Raffle prizes included decorative door hangers, 18" Nothing Bundt Cakes, and a chance to win a Hy-Vee 90 second Fill Your Cart shopping experience at the local 156th & Maple Hy-Vee location. Guests could purchase a bottle of wine from the wine pull or pick a gift card from the gift card tree.

Within a 15 minute time period at the end of the event, patrons raised \$1,900 during the "Fill the Heart" campaign! Falk.

## 20th Annual



On Monday, July 15, 2019, over 160 golfers, volunteers & sponsors joined the fun at Champions Run Golf Course for Elkhorn Public Schools Foundation's 20th annual Golf Fore Grants Tournament. The sold-out event had to be rescheduled from a rain out, but the weather ended up being hot and sunny for all 144 golfers! This year the Golf Fore Grants event raised over \$34,000 to benefit the Foundation's Classroom Grants program, helping fund 71 wishes totaling \$140,000. Technology enhancements, robotics, school plays, anti-bullying rallies, and author grants are examples of a few of the grants approved. The Foundation's Classroom Grants Program directly impacts more than 9,000 students in all of the 17 schools in the Elkhorn Public School District. "We are honored by the investment and time that our volunteers, sponsors and golfers shared with us today. Thank you for helping us fulfill our mission

of encouraging and supporting excellence in innovative education and school programs." stated Stacey L. Falk, Executive Director of the Elkhorn Public Schools Foundation.

The Foundation offered a four person 18-hole afternoon scramble which began with lunch, followed by a noon shotgun start, and ended with a rib-eye dinner buffet. Elkhorn South High School cheerleaders, Elkhorn Kids Campus employees, Foundation Board members, Woodhouse Auto Group, Foundation Friends and volunteers from Sodexo teamed up to help with games all along the course – including opportunities to win a new Alfa Romeo, PITCH Pizzeria Wine Basket, putting green contest and much more.

The grand finale was the awards presentation announcing flag pin prizes consisting of Foundation camp chairs and Bluetooth speakers. Winners were also announced for the poker contest, putting contest, raffle prizes and afternoon tournament champions. 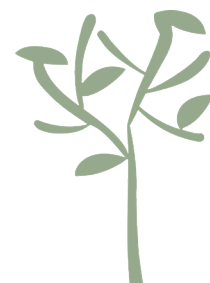

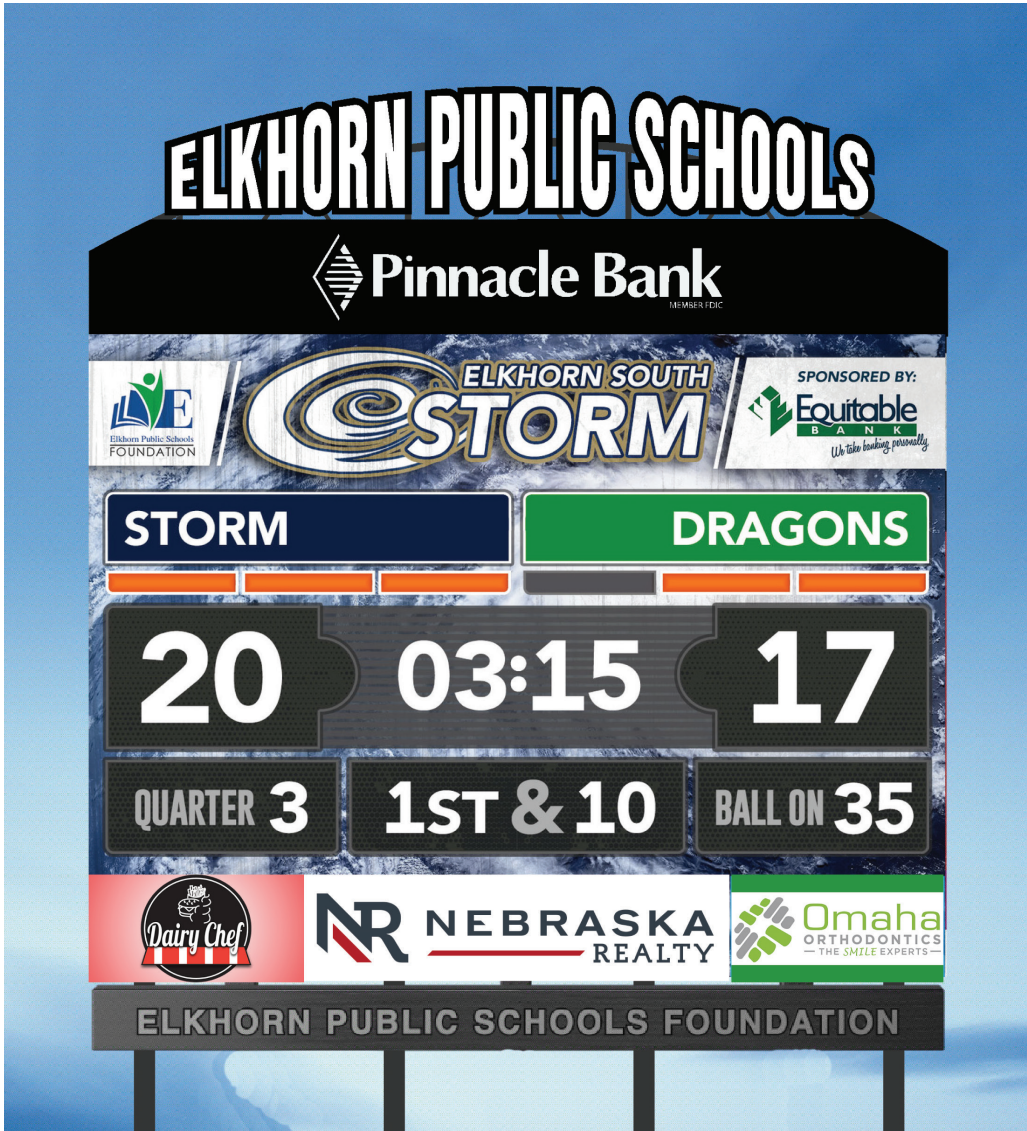

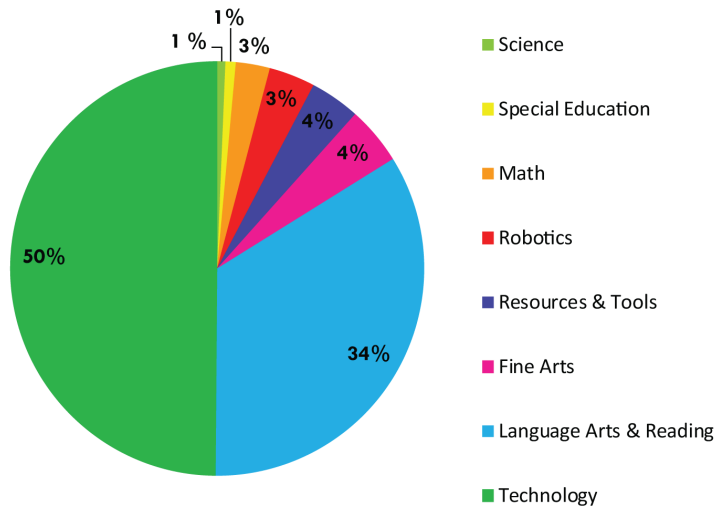
