Manchester Elementary	<u>All-In-One Magnetic Phonics Kit</u>	I am requesting a grant to purchase the Lakeshore All-in-One Magnetic Phonics Kit to support our students who need science-of-reading-aligned phonics instruction, because this hands-on, teacher-ready resource provides color-coded grapheme magnets and a write-and-wipe workspace that allow learners to physically build, decode, and encode words, reinforcing the sound-letter relationships crucial to early literacy development. The kit's movable magnets for vowels, consonants, digraphs, and other phonics elements give students repeated, multisensory opportunities to slow down and attend to how words work, directly supporting explicit, structured phonics practice that research shows is essential for developing decoding and word-analysis skills. In our intervention groups, this tool will help struggling readers gain confidence, strengthen foundational reading skills, and make measurable progress toward grade-level fluency.
