Its wireless design enables the teacher to move freely around the classroom, maintaining proximity to students to support effective classroom management, provide immediate feedback, and increase student focus and accountability. The device will be used across subject areas to model problem-solving strategies, annotate texts, demonstrate writing skills, and highlight student work for discussion and reflection. By supporting visual, auditory, and kinesthetic learners, the document camera promotes equitable access to instruction, improves comprehension, and fosters an interactive and collaborative learning environment.
